



## Streamline videos on Your iPod, Pad or Touch

- Download the video as a Quick Time file (.mov).
  - Underneath the screen where the video plays, check the Quick Time box under “Download Type”.
  - If your district has a server, you may not have the Quick Time option. You may only see Windows Media as an option. In this case, you need to log out and log back in with the generic account we have created for those that don’t have access to Quick Time files: (**NOTE**: this account is **only** for use when downloading QT videos)
    - User Name: ipodsc
    - Password: ipod
- Once the video is on your computer, open iTunes.
- Click on “Movies” at the menu on the left.
- Go to “File” and click “Add to Library”.
- Locate the video you wish to add and click “Import” or “Choose”.
- You should now see the video in the *iTunes* box.
- Click on “Advanced”. For iPod or iPhone, click on “Create iPod or iPhone Version”. For an iPad, click on “Create iPad or Apple TV Version”.
- You will have two copies of the video. Right click on the original one and select “Delete”.
- The next time you sync your iPod, Pad or Touch (plug it into the computer), it will put the video on the device.
