The **ETV Technology Workshop** course is an interactive training course designed to help teachers utilize the StreamlineSC library of K-12 digital media resources and other web related resources. Participants in this course will learn from experts in the field of technology and gain a greater understanding of the new media resources available to them. Hands-on learning experiences will provide teachers with useful ideas and resources for creating lesson plans and using instructional materials right away.

Course Requirements

Participants are required to:

I.

A. Attend three different workshop sessions (one day) at the Teacher Technology Workshop at ETV and complete a lesson plan from each session attended. **Also** view three Professional Development sessions (found on the following pages) and complete the homework assignment from each session viewed.

OR

B. Attend six different sessions (two days) at the Teacher Technology Workshop at ETV and complete a lesson plan from each of the sessions attended.

III. Complete a short survey after attending workshop.

Professional Development Sessions on ETV StreamlineSC

(complete three sessions for course)

Session: Integration Ideas – 50 ways to integrate ETV StreamlineSC into the classroom. This list is found under Professional Development, Trainer’s Toolkit, “Integration Ideas”. Review the entire list. (.5 hour)

Homework: Write at least 2 lesson plans incorporating at least 2 of the ways to integrate ETV StreamlineSC. (1 hour)

Instructor: List is from Discovery Education.

Note: This one should not be done if you attended the “50 Ways to use Streamline” as one of your workshop sessions.

Session: One Page Guides – Review at least 2 of the one page guides found on ETV StreamlineSC (Discovery *streaming*) under Professional Development, Trainer’s Toolkit, in the right side bar. (.5 hour)

Homework: Write a lesson plan for each guide selected, incorporating the resource. (Do not repeat a topic that you saw at the Workshop or in another Professional Development session.) (1 hour)

Instructor: Guides are from Discovery Education or a professional in that field.

Session: Ed Tech Connect – Watch one or two of the pre-recorded Webinars taught by nationally recognized educational technology experts found on ETV StreamlineSC under Professional Development on the right side in the blue box. Click on the Register Here link at the bottom, then click View Event Recordings, and select a webinar. (1 or 2 hours)

Homework: Write a lesson plan incorporating a “new-to-you” technology learned from the webinar. Please list the webinar(s) watched when turning in the homework. (.5 or 1 hour)

(This assignment may count as two of the three PD Sessions if you watch two webinars and complete two homework assignments.)

Instructors: Nationally recognized educational technology experts

Session: Project Demonstrations – Browse through two or four Project Demonstrations related to your classroom that are found on ETV StreamlineSC under Professional Development. (1 or 2 hours)

Homework: Incorporate two or four samples into 1, 2, or more lesson plans. Please list the Project Demonstrations browsed when turning in the homework. (.5 or 1 hour)

(This assignment may count as 2 of the 3 PD Sessions if you browse 4 demonstrations and complete at least 2 lesson plans.)

Instructors: Professionals in their field of expertise.

Session: Watch one of the “24/7 Technology” videos produced by SCETV/ITV in ETV StreamlineSC and take notes (for yourself). (1 hour)

Homework: Apply what you learned from this video to a lesson plan. Please list the video watched when turning in the homework. (.5 hour)

Instructors: Various.
