South Carolina ETV receives three Communicator Awards

COLUMBIA, S.C. – The Academy of Interactive and Visual Arts has announced the winners of the 29th Annual Communicator Awards, with South Carolina ETV (SCETV) receiving three wins.

With around 3,000 entries received from across the U.S. and around the world, the <u>Communicator Awards</u> is the largest and most competitive awards program honoring creative excellence for communications professionals.

Three SCETV promotions were selected to receive the Award of Distinction:

SCETV Safe Space Public Service Announcement

Category: General-Promotions and Contests

Safe Space is a conversational-style television program initiative that brings together teens and professionals to discuss issues facing South Carolina's youth. The <u>SCETV *Safe Space* initiative</u> debuted in September 2022 and is funded by a grant from Twin Cities PBS (TPT) to support a multi-platform production and community engagement initiative to inform, illuminate and activate suicide prevention strategies for vulnerable populations.
