6 – 12th grades

Programming: Benjamin E. Mays: Born to Rebel, Driven to Excel

Assignment: Watch the broadcast and make a case/presentation for nominating Benjamin E. Mays for an exhibit in the SC State Museum.

Essential Question: What are the most important and relevant artifacts needed when creating an exhibit on an historical figure during a particular time period?

Objective: Students will be able to knowledgably discuss the impact of such social justice movements, like the Civil Rights movement, and its impact on the nation and world at large.
